## Introduction:

The theme of unity is vital for the collective progress of the Church. This study explores the importance of maintaining unity in the body of Christ, addressing common issues that cause division and identifying our role in promoting harmony. By examining Paul's teachings in Ephesians 4-6, we'll uncover how unity strengthens the Church, promotes growth, and helps resolve many challenges. We'll also explore the gifts and roles given to believers that contribute to this unified mission, and how grace plays a central role in achieving unity within diverse church communities.

- 1. What issues do we see in the church that divides? (politics, broken leadership teams, different understandings/interpretation of scripture division over methods which are different)
- 2. Just as in a marriage, unity helps to overcome, and division breaks, so it is in the church
- 3. What is our role within the church to promote unity? (bond of peace, love each other, get plugged into God first)
- 4. Chapters 4 6 of Ephesians expounds on what we do to reflect His work and power back to Him.

- 6. How does unity bring progress to the church?

- 16. In v15, if Christ is the figurative head of the body, what does that mean about us?
- 17. How does this translate to trans-local ministries or missions?
- 18. What is your next step or challenge in maturity in serving God?
- 19. Humility is essential, as God puts part of His Spirit in us, for different works, we need to recognise that as believers are part of one body, God sees value in all of us. Titles in the church should not be according to gifts, as we have ALL been given a 'grace' gift. And all gifts are important.
